Revocation

In relation to the current National Selection Policy, in accordance with

- Section 15 of the AIR Constitution and
- Section 2 of the 2018/2019 AIR National Selection Policy,

as of Friday 26/04/2019, the AIR Board has revoked the 2018/2019 National Selection Policy as the competitions it related to have now been completed.

The 2019/2020 National Selection Policy will be released in the near future. it is intended that the qualification times will not change from the previous policy, however the dates of eligible times are likely to be from 01/09/2018.

As previously disseminated, the following will be compulsory for any skater wishing to compete for Australia in a 2019/2020 World Cup or Senior World Championship:

- 3-month National Camp - commencing Melbourne 8th May 2019;
- World Cup and World Championship selection trials - date TBC, venue O'Brien Icehouse;
- Contest the 2019 Australian open Short Track championships.

International Competition Subsidy Program

The AIR Board is presently reviewing how funding will be used to promote excellence and high performance results for our sport which is what the funding is intended to assist. Subsequently, we have decided to suspend the International Competition Subsidy Program whilst it is reviewed.
