**Conditions:** This competition is Open to all registered **Club members only**  
Skaters may enter only one division.  
Skaters who have a recognised time of 52 sec or under may skate in Open Div.  
Age is based on your age on **July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020**  
If there are **less** than 3 in a division the groups **may** be combined.

**Program-** There are two competitions within this event.

- (a) Individual competition
- (b) Relay competition

**INDIVIDUAL** Skaters will have minimum 5 individual races.

Skaters must complete all races in the individual section for points to be awarded. *(Excluding the case in which the skater falls, is injured or receives a penalty)*

Points awarded in finals only. In the event of a tie, the winner will be:

- For Masters, Sub Juniors, Juniors and Open: the skater with the fastest 500m.
- For Nippers and Midgets: the skater with the fastest 222m.

**Prizes - Individual** Trophies will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> places to skaters in the **actual division** they race in  
Certificates will be awarded to 4<sup>th</sup> place down

**RELAY** Each team must have 4 skaters.  
A division must have at least two teams for the race to be held.  
Teams will wear different coloured helmet covers or vests for this event.

### Conditions for skaters

1. Skaters must be able to skate unassisted to participate in this competition.
2. Skaters must wear a helmet, gloves, and long sleeve jumper/jacket and pants (no shorts). Knee pads are recommended. The rink can provide helmets and knee pads for the competition if required.
3. It is preferable for skaters to wear speed skates for this event, but figure/hockey skates are also allowed. Speak to your local club if you require assistance with any equipment.
4. Helmet covers will be provided for each skater for the event and must be returned at the conclusion of the competition.

### Program

- Skaters will be placed into groups prior to the competition.
- The number of groups depends on the number of entries received.

**Certificates will be awarded to skaters at the conclusion of the competition.**
