PRECAUTION

- IRSNW and Canterbury Olympic Ice Rink are applying strict COVID Safety measures during the competition, including recording details of everyone who enters the rink for contact tracing purposes.
- WE STRONGLY ADVISE THE USE OF FACE MASKS AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN THE VENUE



MUST FOLLOW

- QR (Barcode) will be provided – therefore, you can register upon arrival by scanning the code with your smartphone
- Please ensure you are driving directly from your home to the rink – Avoid making any stop on route to the rink.
- In order to reduce the risk of COVID within the rink – We will be limiting the amount of spectators in the rink – Therefore, each skater will be accompanied by ONE adult only.
- Everyone will be required to wear a mask – If you do not have one – We will provide you with a mask upon arrival at the rink.
- Medal presentations will be held ON ICE – to reduce close contact. Certificates will be distributed to the clubs after the event.
- Please DO NOT gather in any form/ groups after the competition.

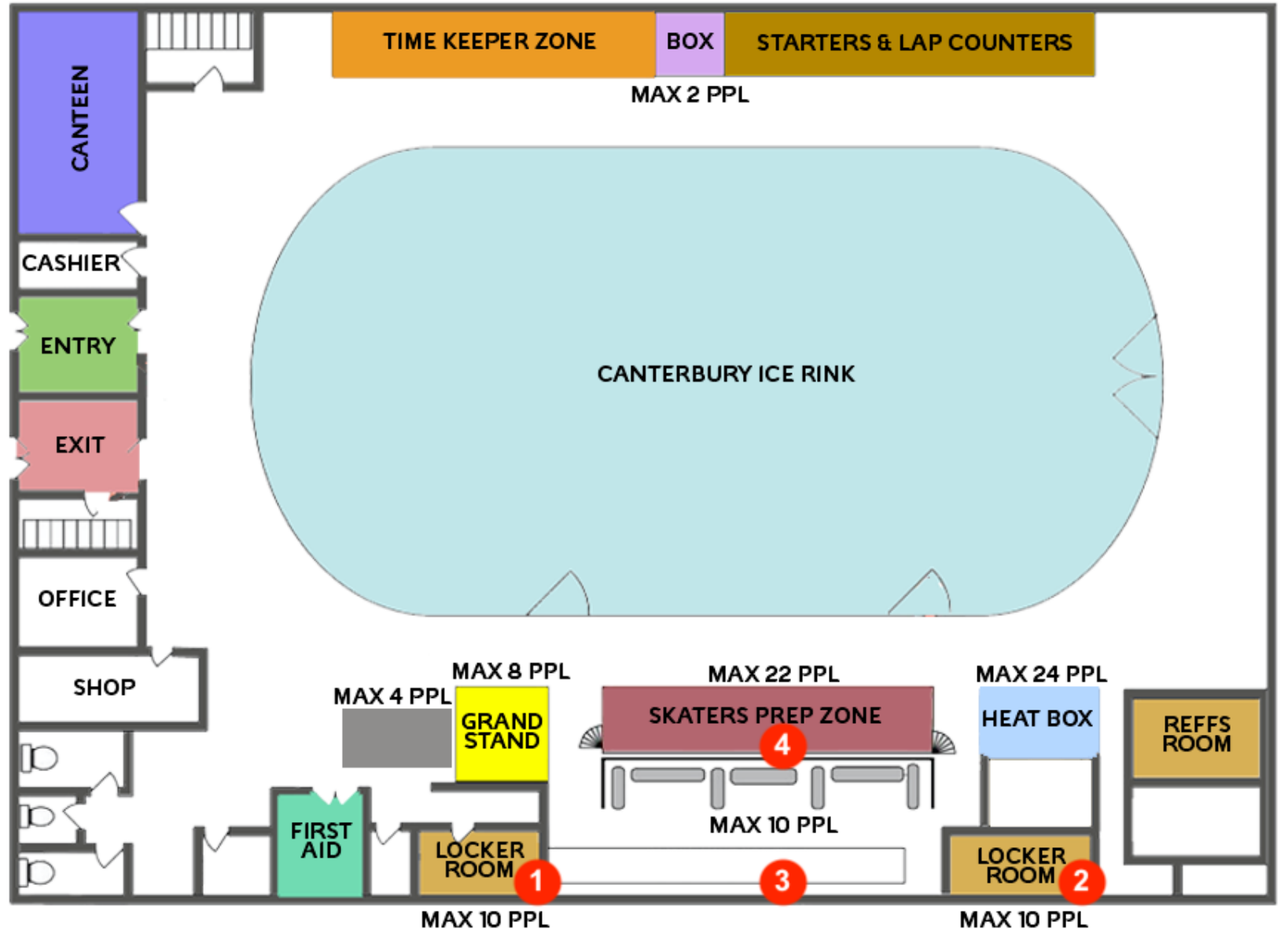

GUIDELINES TO FOLLOW


- 1** **LOCKER ROOM 1**

- 2** **LOCKER ROOM 2**

- 4** **LOCKER ROOM 3**
SENIOR, MASTERS & SCHOOL


 **RINK ENTRANCE**
This entrance is to be use ONLY when entering the Ice Rink


 **RINK EXIT**
This exit is to be used ONLY when leaving the Ice Rink


 **CANTEEN (GUIDELINES APPLY)**
The canteen will be open to serve refreshments and snacks – However, the seating area inside will be OUT OF BOUNDS – There will be markers set up as a ONE WAY in and out method. PLEASE do not remain inside the canteen once you have received your order.

 **ICE RINK**
On-Ice referees will keep distance as per usual – Skaters will be directed when and how to enter and leave the rink upon commencement of the race.


 **SPECTATOR SEATING AREA**
Spectator seating will be available with markers set to distance everyone from each other (unless you are from the same household) please ensure you keeping 1.5m distance from each other.


 **FIRST AID**
In the case of any injuries – The first aid room will be available – Distance measures will apply.


 **SKATER PREP ZONE / HEAT BOX**
Markers will be placed to distance all skaters while preparing for their race – Heat box will only be open when the race is upcoming – Please do not remain if you do not have an upcoming race

 **LOCKER ROOMS**
Each CLUB will be assigned a locker room – There will be distance measures taken along with maximum occupancies within the locker rooms

 **TECHNICAL OFFICIAL BOX**
Maximum of 2 technical officials may remain inside the box.

 **TIMEKEEPER ZONE**
Only timekeepers will be allowed to access this zone – distance measures will be in place.

 **HEAT BOX**
Skaters who are racing – we will call skaters per event to avoid extra time being spend in the heat box

 **STARTERS AND LAP COUNTERS**
Only Starters and lap counters have access this zone – distance measures will be in place.
