



Active Kids Rebate

Both the Ice Racing New South Wales and the Sydney Arrows Ice Racing Club are registered providers of the Active Kids Program. You may use the rebate voucher (max \$100 per child) on your training fees (Sydney Arrows members only) or membership fee (both Sydney Arrows members and Sydney Speed Skating members) but you must pay your membership to Australian Ice Racing (AIR) first before claiming a rebate from Ice Racing NSW.

If you ALREADY have an Active Kids Voucher waiting to be claimed, please email the voucher to treasurer.irnsw@gmail.com along with your receipt from Australian Ice Racing for 2018/19 membership payment to claim your rebate. For Sydney Arrows members, you have the option to send the voucher to sydneyarrows@gmail.com to claim a rebate on your training.

How to Apply Active Kids Voucher Online

Step 1: Go to Services NSW by visiting <https://www.service.nsw.gov.au/>

Step 2: If you already have an account with Service NSW, go to the next step otherwise create an account first.

Step 3: Under tab “Services”, click “Apply for voucher”
